The MASCC/ISOO <u>Oral Care Study Group</u> and the <u>International Society of Oral Oncology</u> (ISOO) have together created four multilingual Fact Sheets for patients receiving chemotherapy and those undergoing head and neck radiation therapy. These Fact Sheets result from the collaboration of physicians, nurses, dietitians, speech language pathologists, dentists, radiation therapists and social workers committed to supportive care. They are based on systematic reviews and guideline development and reflect up-to-date, evidenced-based recommendations for managing the oral complications of cancer therapy, as well as the most current thinking about knowledge translation and delivery to patients.


- Mucositis Management for Patients Treated with Chemotherapy

Each Information Sheet is written in plain language without extensive use of medical terms. The Information Sheets are available — under Practice Resources/Patient Education and the Mucositis Study Group page on the MASCC website — for clinicians to download and distribute to their patients if they so desire.


The Information Sheets are designed for patients undergoing cytotoxic treatment, hematopoietic stem cell transplantation, or radiation to the head and neck region. They are organized in a print-ready format, with simple graphic icons to identify guidelines in favor of or against various interventions.

Adherence to any intervention, with either preventive or therapeutic intent, depends on patients' having correct information and understanding the treatment. This information should be as clear as possible and available to patients who may be overwhelmed by newly diagnosed cancer. The Study Group hopes that these Information Sheets will be of use to clinicians who need resources for their patients.


